

# Imperial Falcion (Custus Pattern) Mark I



Before the Shadowword, there was the Falcion. The Shadowword is a much more sophisticated piece of machinery, but the Falcion still has a place as a venerable old workhorse. Firing a solid shell in place of the massive energy discharge of the turbolaser, the Falcion lacks the massive strength of the Shadowword, but has a more powerful blast.

Custus Forgeworld was a small Forgeworld dedicated to manufacturing only the largest war machines before it was declared rogue and suffered the fate of exterminatus in 989M41. Custus produced the Falcion in large numbers prior to its destruction and because of that, a large number of Falcion's are still in service, their main gun being relatively easy to maintain compared to the more sophisticated turbolaser. However, they are rapidly falling out of favor and they replaced by Shadowwords as they are destroyed.

In this way, the Falcion is slowly going extinct..

**Modeling:** The Falcion is an OOP model originally produced by Armorcast.

#### SPECIAL RULES

**Terrain:** A 2<sup>nd</sup> Generation baneblade can ignore low walls, hedges, bushes, and rubble.

**War Machine:** As a war machine, instead of picking a target for the vehicle, pick a target for each of its weapons. Further, the 2<sup>nd</sup> generation baneblade may always fire all of its weapons and never counts as moving for the purposes of firing weapons.
