

Mars Pattern Mark IIb “Fury” Dreadnought



The Fury Class Dreadnought is based on a little known Pre-Heresy STC, which is has almost been completely forgotten and long since lost. Those inordinately rare suits that still function are universally held by Marine chapters which can date their history back to before the Heresy and even some of those chapters will not have a functioning example.

Like its brother the Chuck class, the Fury was/is intended to support fast-attack units (bikes and jump troops). The smaller size and lighter armor coupled with the souped up engine allow the Fury Class Dreadnought to achieve much faster speeds than the current dreadnought used by the rest of the Adeptus Astartes.

The Fury trades one close combat weapon from the Chuck class for a single mount lascannon to provide the Fury with long range tank hunting ability. Therefore, it is a more rounded and versatile design, but some of the benefits of its speed are not always used. The single mount lascannon is believed to have originally been used, by those members of the Mechanicus who would speculate, as twin linked weapons at the time took a larger mount than the smaller Mark II dreadnought chassis could tolerate.

Like the Chuck class dreadnought, those chapters with Fury class dreadnought suits treat them with utmost respect and awe, and in many cases will not even admit to their existence.

Substitution: A "Fury" class dreadnought may be taken instead of a venerable dreadnought wherever a venerable dreadnought may be taken. Fury dreadnoughts are however only available to first founding chapters

Options: : The Fury Class Dreadnought is an ancient weapon of war dating back to a time when the Emperor himself walked amongst men. Thus the knowledge for upgrading and modifying the Fury has been long lost to the ages and the chassis simply cannot accept more modern upgrades. Therefore, the Fury Class Dreadnought may not be given any additional upgrades and must be fielded as is.

Modeling: The Model is based on the original Space Marine Dreadnought Chassis modeled with an older style lascannon and dreadnought power fist (dreadnought close combat weapon) mounted with twin-linked bolters.
